4.1.1 Reassessment- [Reporting Most Recent Evidence of Learning](#)

4.1.1.1 Purpose is so only the most recent and powerful evidence of student learning during grade reporting periods. All, or nearly all, of a student's grade will be made up of scores on assessments that are given after the teacher expects the students have learned the content. Discussed practice opportunities for students so that they can have more opportunities to show mastery in standards.

4.1.2 Removing Behavior- [Removing Behavior from Grades](#)

4.1.2.1 We are working on separating students grades from behaviors.

4.1.3 The Equity Grading Scale- [Eliminating the Use of Zeros from Grade Calculation](#)

4.1.3.1 To better serve students, we are improving how we report student progress. To ensure accuracy of grades, we are eliminating the use of zeros when student assignments or tests have not been submitted. This will help us more appropriately determine your student's achievement, as we do not know their skill level when the work has not yet been submitted.
